## ELEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL "OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 30767, as amended, in this proceeding authorized applicant to transport groceries and certain other articles for Western States Grocery Company and Safeway Stores, Inc. from Stockton and Tracy to designated points in Central California, at less than the established minimum rates until November 5, 1946. Applicant now seeks a one-year extension and modification of this authority so as to exclude certain points and to revise the rates to the remaining points.

The verified supplemental application shows that proprietary operations have replaced applicant's service to many points, making continuation of minimum rate authority to such points unnecessary; that certain increases in operating costs have occurred since this matter was last considered; that the increased rates proposed to the points remaining to be served will return these increased costs, plus a reasonable profit; and that in all other respects the conditions shown in support of the original application continue in effect.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that J. P. Spaenhower be and he is hereby authorized to assess and collect for the transportation

of the property from and to the points for which rates are provided in Appendix "A" attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof, rates less than the minimum rates heretofore prescribed in Decision No. 31606, as amended, in Case No. 4246, but not less than the rates provided in said Appendix "A"; that Appendix "A" of Decision No. 30767 of April 11, 1938, as amended, be and it is hereby cancelled; and that, as herein amended, the authority granted by said Decision No. 30767 be and it is hereby extended to November 5, 1947, unless sooner changed, cancelled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

## Application-of-Appendix

Except as otherwise indicated in connection with the individual rates, rates in this appendix apply only for the transportation of all property for Western States Grocery Company or Safeway Stores, Inc. from Stockton to the points shown hereinbelow.

Minimum weight shall be 10,000 pounds per vehicle or vehicles operated as one unit, per trip.

Minimum rates are stated in cents per 100 pounds.
