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ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company seeks authority to single track that portion of its Seaside Park Line between Pico Avenue and Mendocino Avenue in the City of Long Beach, involving the retirement and removal of 2,681 feet of outbound track. The present use of this line is for occasional loading and unloading of freight cars and storage of cars, and applicant alleges that single-track operations are entirely feasible for this type of service. It appears that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to single track its Seaside Park Line between Pico Avenue and Mendocino Avenue, Long Beach, California, in accordance with the description contained in the application. Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission in writing of abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof, unless

further time is granted by subsequent order. The authority herein granted shall become effective immediately.
