ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

It appearing that DOYLE R. SORENSON, doing business as Sorenson Drayage Company, Marysville, California, has requested in writing that the Commission cancel his highway common carrier certificate authorizing service between Chico and Chico Basic Flying School, upon the ground that said flying school has been closed and that no highway common carrier operations have been conducted or will be conducted in the future by said carrier between the points authorized to be served by said operative right; and

It further appearing that the operative right as to which cancellation is sought herein was originally granted to one J. H. Ballew by Decision No. 35163, dated March 24, 1942, as supplemented by Decision No. 35633, dated August 4, 1942, in Application No. 24807, and was acquired by Sorenson pursuant to Decision No. 38413, dated November 20, 1945, in Application No. 26955;

THEREFORE, GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, IT IS ORDERED that the certificate held by Doyle R. Sorenson to conduct a highway

common carrier service between Chico and Chico Basic Flying School be and it is hereby revoked, and all tariffs and schedules on file with the Commission in connection with said operation are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
