ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 38472, dated December 10, 1945, and Decision No. 38784, dated March 19, 1946, Elmer H. Hunt, doing business as Garden Grove Bus: Co., was certificated to conduct passenger stage operations between Anaheim and Huntington Beach and between Garden Grove and Long Beach.
