## BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of Drill Track (Siding) across Kettleman Lane, in the City of Lodi, County of San Joaquin, State of California. )  
 Application No. 27911 )

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Kettleman Lane near Lodi, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. D-102:0. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding existing grades. Protection shall be by existing Standard crossing signs and signals which may be moved to new location. Said signals shall be connected to protect against movement on the drill track crossing authorized herein. Crossing shall also be flood lighted.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
