O R D E R

Contra Costa County is authorized to widen the crossing of Loveridge Road across the tracks of The Atchison Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company near Pittsburg, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application, and identified as Crossing No. 2-1154.1. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 44 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection will be determined and its cost allocated by further order on this application.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
