OPINION AND ORDER

Smithson Springs Water Company has applied to the Rail-road Commission for authority to issue and sell \$4,500 par value of its common capital stock, at par for cash, for the purpose of paying indebtedness and of financing the cost of improvements to its water system.

It appears that applicant has purchased from Alfred W. Mondorf, for \$13,250, certain properties including a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a water system near Phelan, San Bernardino County, 155 acres of land and certain water properties; that pursuant to authority granted by Decision No. 39227, dated July 30, 1946, it issued to said Mondorf \$10,500 par value of stock in part payment for said properties; and that it is now obligated to said Mondorf in the sum of \$2,750 for the balance of the purchase price.

The corporation now desires to issue additional shares of stock, in the aggregate amount of \$4,500, to discharge its liability to Mondorf and to provide \$1,850 said to be necessary to complete needed improvements to its water properties. Its requirements are set forth in the application as follows:

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary, that the application should be granted, as herein provided, and that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for through the issue of said stock is reasonably required for the purposes specified herein, which purposes are not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- 1. Smithson Springs Water Company may issue and sell at par for cash, on or before February 28, 1947, not exceeding \$4,500 par value of its common capital stock and use the proceeds to pay \$2,750 due Alfred W. Mondorf and to finance the expenditures for improvements to its water properties referred to herein.
- 2. Smithson Springs Water Company shall file with the Commission reports of the issue of the stock herein authorized and of the disposition of the proceeds as required by the Commission's General Order No. 24-A, which order, insofar as applicable, is made a part of this order.

3. The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
