## OPINION

Applicant Zarbor Transit Company operates a passenger stage service betreen Oxnamd and Eollywood Seach and intermediate points, and in inis application requests a certificate autiorizing the extension of that service between Oxnard and Point Wugu and between Oxnard and Point Xugu, via Port Eueneme, inciuding intermediate points.

Point Xugu is iocated 10.5 miles soutineast of Oxnard and Port Eueneme is 5.8 miles south of Oxnard. The distance between Oxnard and Foint Kugu via Port Eueneme fo enom to bc 13.3 miles.

The application sets forth thet there tas recentiy been establisned at Zoint Kugu a Unitec States Naval Air Focility for the conduct of certain experimental tests. Several hundred civilians and a considerable navy personnel are employed at the Air Facility, so it is alleged. Kany of these empioyees live a Oxnare and Port Eueneme and requive public transportation which coordinates with their worikng hours. Such a service is not now provided.

Applicant proposes to charge a one-way tare op-20 cents between Oxnard and Point Kugu by way of either U.S. highway 101 or via Port Fueneme and 15 cents between Oxnard and Eort Eueneme. Four
scinedules will be operated dally, two directiy betweer Oxnard and Point Kugh anc two via Port Hueneme. Applicant's equipment consists of two 41-passenger buses.

Pacific Greyhound Lines conduct a passenger service olong U. S. Eighway No. 102 between Oxnard and Point Mugu. Nis carrier has advised the Commission that it does not desire to oppose the gronting of the appiscation. The proposed eservice is favored by the Commanding Officer of the Air Facility at Point Mugu, who states in a Letter to the Commission that the need for the proposed service is unsent.

It appears that the service proposed will meet a pubile need. The applicatien will be granted. A public hearing does not eppear to be neceasamy.

Farbor Sransit Company is hereby placed upon notice that operative rights, as such, do not constitute a class of property which may be capitalized on used as on element of value in rate-fixing for eny amount of money in excess of that originally poid to the state as the consiaeraiton for the grent of auch ringts. Aside from their purely permissive aspect, they extend to the holier a full or partiel monopoly of a class of business over a particular route. Shis monoDoiy feature may be changed or destroyed at any time by the State, which is not in any respeot $11 m 1 t e d$ to the number of rights which may be giver.

An applicetion beving been made as above entitied and the Commission oeing fuliy advised in the matter,

IT IS ORDERED O. follows:
(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessizy be and $1 t$ hereby is granted to पarbor Transit Company, authorizing the estabinshment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as jefined $1:$ Section $2 \frac{3}{4}$ of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers between Oxnard and Point Mugn and between oxnard and Port Hueneme and invermediate points.
(2) That in providing servise pursuant to the certificate herein granted, appilcant shail comply with and observe the rollowing service reguiations:
a. Appicant shall ille a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed 30 days from the effective date hereof.
b. Applicant shail comply with the provisions of General Orcer No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A, by z11ing in triplicate, and concurrentiy making effective, aupropriate tarifis and time vables withit 60 deys from the effective date hereof ard on not less than 1 day's notice to the Comilission and tine public.
c. Subject to tise authoring of timis Commisoion to change or modify it by furtiner owder, appilcont shail conduct operations pursuant to said cenzificate over and alons the following route:

Begining at Fourtin ani A Stmeets (Time Point) Oxnara, thence along A Stree to Fifth Street, thence aiong Eapti Siveet to Vontura Rood, thence slong Ventura Roac to Pieasant Voher Road, thence siong pleasant Valiey Zoed to San Fedro street, thence olong San Redro Stree to Woin Street, thence along kan Stree to Karket Street, thence aiong Market Street to Eueneme Road, thence siong Eueneme Rood, to 101 Asternate EAgray, thence along 101 divernate \#ighway to Mair Gare, Point Kugu.
3eginning as Fourth and $A$ Streets (Inme Point) Onnard, thence aione A Street to Fifth Street, thence along Finth Street to Ventuma Road, thence along Ventura Roed to wooley Road, thence along vooley Road to 101 Alternate Elghway, tience along 101 divernate Eighway to Main Gate, Point tugu.

Applicant may urn its motor vehicies at Jermini or intermediate points either in tie intersection of the street or by operating around a block, in either direction, contiguous to such intersection.
