In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing it to reclassify its Class "C" non-agency station of Garus, California, to a Class "E" non-agency station.

ORDER.

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's Class "C" station of Garus for more than one year and that continued maintenance as a Class "C" station is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Garus, County of Santa Barbara, from Class "C" to Class "E", a station at which freight will not be handled; to change station records; and to cancel all freight tariffs applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
