O P I N I O N

Applicant D. Moyers presently provides a passenger stage service between Fresno and Orange Cove via Centerville over Ventura Avenue and other streets and highways and also provides a passenger stage service between Fresno and Sanger via Jensen Avenue.

By the above entitled application, applicant requests authority to establish an alternate routing of his Fresno-Orange Cove line so that he may operate over Rainbow Road between Centerville, on the Fresno-Orange Cove line, and Sanger on the Fresno-Sanger line.

In support of this request, the application states that frequently the number of passengers traveling between Fresno and Sanger is in excess of the seating accommodations of the present equipment used on this route; that operation of schedules between Fresno and Orange Cove over the proposed alternate route between Sanger & Centerville would enable him to provide additional schedules between Fresno and Sanger and also to provide a service along the alternate route. There is no proposal to change the present fare structure between points now served by applicant, and the proposed fares along the alternate route would be on a level with the fares between points on the presently authorized routes.

There is no other common carrier of passengers operating between the points involved in this application, and after full consideration of applicant's request, it is our judgment that no public hearing is necessary and the application should be granted.

O R D E R

An application therefor having been filed and it being hereby found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to D. Moyers authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation as such term is defined in Section 22 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers between the intersection of Academy Road and Ventura Avenue and Centerville over and along Academy Road and Rainbow Avenue, as an extension and enlargement of and consolidated with the operative rights created by Decision No. 58574.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- a. Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed 30 days from the effective date hereof.
- b. Within 60 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A, by filing in triplicate and concurrently making effective, appropriate tariffs and time tables.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
