In the Matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of railroad industrial drill track across Pellett Avenue and Terven Avenue, at Spreckels Junction, County of Monterey, State of California.

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across Pellett Avenue and Terven Avenue, near Salinas, Monterey County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. E-120.4-C and E-120.58-C respectively.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B) at each crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
