

Decision No. 39638

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of railroad industrial drill track across Old County Road, in and across Harbor Boulevard and in and across the alley next northerly therefrom, at or near Belmont, County of San Mateo, State of California.

**ORIGINAL**

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across Old County Road, an unimproved alley and Harbor Boulevard near Belmont, San Mateo County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as follows:

Old County Road as Crossing No. E-22:25-C

Harbor Boulevard as Crossing No. E-22.35-C

This order shall not be considered as authority for opening the alley across said drill track. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) at Old County Road and Harbor Boulevard. This authority is given subject to the condition that at such time as in the judgment of this Commission the volume and nature of the traffic on the highways or the drill track so warrants, applicant shall at its own expense install such special protection as the Commission may direct.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,

necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
