ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 39570 AND DENYING REHEARING

Pacific Motor Trucking Company and M. P. Fischer (Downieville Stage Company) having petitioned for a rehearing of Decision No. 39570 and it appearing that the order in said decision should be amended to conform to the application and proof thereon, IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph numbered (1) in Decision No. 39570 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Edward J. Fournier authorizing him to operate as a highway common carrier, as defined in Section 2-3/4 of the Public Utilities Act, between Sacramento, on the one hand, and Indian Flat and Downieville and intermediate points, on the the other hand, and locally between Indian Flat and Downieville."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that rehearing of said decision, as amended, is hereby denied.
