

Decision No. 39687

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades of the State highway, Route 4, and the tracks of the Southern Pacific Railroad in the vicinity of Oil Junction, in the County of Kern, State of California.

O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route 4 at separated grades over the main line and a side track of Southern Pacific Company near Oil Junction, Kern County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-308.0-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing, and copy of said agreement together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
