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## BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the application of PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY for an order granting and conferring upon applicant all necessary permission and authority to furnish and supply propane gas service (in lieu of manufactured gas service) in Grass Valley, Nevada City, and suburbs of each, and intervening territory, and in Redding and Red Bluff, and the suburbs of each, and to file and make effective rates applicable to said propane gas service, etc.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

WHEREAS: Pacific Gas and Electric Company was authorized by Decision No. 39565 to file and make effective a general service schedule for propane gas service in and about Grass Valley and Nevada City, Redding and suburbs and Red Bluff and suburbs, as contained in Exhibit "B" of the application, which was premised on the rendition of propane-air gas having a heating value of 1050 Btu per cubic foot, and

WHEREAS: It developed during the cutover to propane-air gas service in Grass Valley and Nevada City that the appropriate heating value of the gas to be served, from the standpoint of the most satisfactory operation of customers' appliances, will average 925 Btu per cubic foot, and

WHEREAS: Pacific Gas and Electric Company, by Advice No. 39-G, filed on December 4, 1946 a modification of the rate schedule authorized by Decision No. 39565, reducing the rates therein to correspond to the lower heating value adopted; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company is hereby authorized to file a general service schedule for propane gas service as contained in Revised C.R.C. Sheet No. 1651-G and filed by Advice No. 39-G, to be effective on regular monthly meter readings taken on and after the fifteenth day

following completion of the cutover from manufactured gas service to propane-air gas service in Grass Valley, Nevada City, and suburbs of each and intervening territory, and to be appropriately modified as to "territory" as said propane gas service is extended to Redding and suburbs and Red Bluff and suburbs.

Except as herein modified, the order in Decision No. 39565 shall remain unchanged.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
