ORDER OF REVOCATION

"Will you please revoke our certificate to transport passengers from points between Los Angeles and the California Shipbuilding Corporation yard on Terminal Island, Wilmington, California, because of the cessation of operation?"

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative right created by Decision No. 37539 in Application No. 26289, is hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Victory Riders' Club are hereby cancelled.
