ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing that during the year 1915 C. E. Sansome began passenger stage operations between Maricopa and Taft, which service, with the addition of express matter, was subsequently extended to include Associated, Bakersfield, Bear Creek, Elk Hills, Fallows, Hayes Lease, Maricopa, McKittrick, Santa Fe Section 9, Standard, Standard "36", Taft, Tuttmann [Tupman], and intermediate points;

It further appearing that since about July 1, 1944, the said services have been discontinued without authority; that the 1945 Annual Report of said carrier states that no operations were performed during said year; that Commission staff investigations of October, 1946, have disclosed that none of the aforesaid carrier operations or services is currently rendered; and it being found that said C. E. Sansome has discontinued all operations and services hereinabove described, without authority of the Commission, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that whatever prescriptive rights may be held by said C. E. Sansome for the operation of a passenger stage service between Taft and Maricopa, and intermediate points, and as evidenced by tariffs and time schedules filed with the Commission, together with all operative rights of whatsoever character created or acquired by the following proceedings, to-wit:

be and the same are hereby revoked, and all such effective tariffs and time schedules hereby cancelled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service thereof in the manner provided by law, unless said C. E. Sansome, before such effective date, shall have filed with the Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
