IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each of said licenses shall . expire on December 31, 1947, subject to the provisions for renewal prescribed by the Commission; provided, however, that each of said licenses shall be inoperative and of no force or effect during any period when there shall not be in effect and on file with the Commission a good and sufficient surety bond provided by the licensee in accordance with the provisions of Section 8 of said Act and the rules and regulations of the Commission. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to issue and deliver to each of the aforementioned licensees a License Certificate of the authority granted hereby. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each of the above-described licenses be issued upon the condition that operations authorized thereunder shall be conducted in accordance with all applicable 2. .

rules, regulations and requirements relating thereto issued by the Commission under the Motor Carrier Transportation Agent Act,
Statutes 1933, Chapter 390, as amended.
