SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Licenses to engage in the business of a motor carrier transportation agent were originally granted to applicants above-named as follows:

The licenses, including outstanding renewals thereof, expire December 31, 1946, and are renewable subject to the provisions prescribed by the Commission.

Each licensee has now filed a timely application for renewal of his license for 1947. A public hearing is not necessary and the licenses will be renewed.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that each of the following named persons is hereby licensed to engage in the business, or act in the capacity, of a motor carrier transportation agent, as defined in Chapter 390, Statutes 1933, as amended, only at the location set opposite his name, to-wit:

to sell, offer for sale, negotiate for, furnish or provide transportation to be furnished by motor carriers, as defined in Chapter 390, Statutes 1933, as amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each of said licenses shall expire on December 31, 1947, subject to the provisions for renewal prescribed by the Commission; provided, however, that each of said licenses shall be inoperative and of no force or effect during any period when there shall not be in effect and on file with the Commission a good and sufficient surety bond provided by the licensee in accordance with the provisions of Section 8 of said Act and the rules and regulations of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to issue and deliver to each of the aforementioned licensees a License Certificate of the authority granted hereby.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each of the above-described licenses be issued upon the condition that operations authorized thereunder shall be conducted in accordance with all applicable

rules, regulations and requirements relating thereto issued by the Commission under the Motor Carrier Transportation Agent Act, Statutes 1933, Chapter 390, as amended.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
