O R D E R

Applicant herein requests authority to modify the easterly end on its No. 78, 13th Street Line in Contra Costa County, east of the City of Richmond. Applicant alleges that it is desirous to make this small modification of the route in order to better serve the territory. The said motor coach route was authorized by Decision No. 38456 in Application No. 19502, 84th Supplemental.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the portion of Service Regulation, paragraph (2), entitled 13th Street Route in Section II of the order in Decision No. 38456 be added to and amended to read as follows:

THIRTEENTH STREET ROUTE: Along 13th Street and Rumrill Boulevard (13th Street extension) from the intersection of Rheem Avenue to 17th Street, along 17th Street to Broadway, along Broadway to Lake Street, along Lake Street to 11th Street, along 11th Street to Rivers Street, along Rivers Street to Broadway, along Broadway to 17th Street, and return via the balance of described route.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Key System is authorized to abandon its motor coach service along Broadway between Rivers Street and 11th Street, along 11th Street between Broadway and Rivers Street, subject to the condition that applicant shall give not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public of the change in service herein authorized. For all other purposes Decision No. 38456 shall remain in full force and effect.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
