ORDER.

The County of Orange is authorized to widen Harbor Boulevard, Crossing No. 6N-29.94, at grade across the Santa Ana Line of Pacific Electric Railway Company in the City of Orange, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall not be less than 45 feet and grades of approach not greater than 3%. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
