OPINION AND ORDER

W. F. Heesch and C. A. Heesch, copartners, applied to this Commission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a waterworks in competitive territory in West Sacramento in the County of Yolo. A public hearing was held in this matter at Sacramento on the twelfth day of April, 1946, at which time the proceeding was adjourned to a date to be set, in order to permit applicants to present to the Commission certain essential evidence supporting the allegations set forth in the application.

Several months have now elapsed and no effort has been made by said applicants to submit at a public hearing the evidence necessary to a just and proper determination of the serious issues involved herein. No request for an adjourned hearing in this matter has been made by or in behalf of applicants.

By reason of these facts and other good cause appearing, I am of the opinion that this matter should be dismissed; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby dismissed.
