FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 39132, rendered June 25, 1946, in Application No. 27320, the Commission granted to Rogers M. Barron a license to engage in the business of a motor carrier transportation agent. Said license expires December 31, 1946, and is renewable, subject to the provisions prescribed by the Commission.

Barron has now filed an application for a renewal of said license and also to change the location at which he proposes to engage in business. A public hearing is not necessary and the license will be renewed.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Rogers M. Barron is hereby licensed to engage in the business, or act in the capacity, of a motor carrier transportation agent, as defined in Chapter 390, Statutes 1933, as amended, only at the following location, to-wit: 624 South Alvarado Street, Los Angeles, California.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this license shall expire on December 31, 1947, subject to the provisions for renewal prescribed by the Public Utilities Commission; provided, however, that this license shall be inoperative and of no force or effect during any period when said Rogers M. Barron shall not have on file with the Public Utilities Commission a good and sufficient surety bond in

accordance with the provisions of Section 8 of said Act and the rules and regulations of the Public Utilities Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Secretary of the Public Utilities Commission be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue and deliver to said Rogers M. Barron a license certificate of the authority granted hereby.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above described license be issued upon the condition that operations authorized thereunder shall be conducted in accordance with all applicable rules, regulations and requirements relating thereto issued by the Commission under the Motor Carrier Transportation Agent Act, Statutes 1933, Chapter 390, as amended.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
