FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 39681, dated December 3, 1946, in Application No. 27821, the Commission granted to John Joseph Shea a license to engage in the business of a motor transportation broker. The license expires December 31, 1946, and is renewable, subject to the provisions prescribed by the Commission.

Shea has now filed an application for a renewal of his license and also to change the location at which he proposes to engage in business.

The license will be renewed. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the application of John Joseph Shea for renewal of his license as a motor transportation broker, as defined in Chapter 705, Statutes 1935, be, and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. That said licensee shall keep his license certificate as motor transportation broker open at all times to public inspection.
2. That said licensee shall do business as a motor transportation broker only at the location set forth in his application for renewal of license, and for the motor carriers for whom he has heretofore been authorized by order of the Commission to do business, or for whom he may

from time to time be permitted to do business by this or any subsequent order or orders of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Secretary of the Public Utilities Commission be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue and deliver to said John Joseph Shea a license certificate of the authority granted hereby.

In all other respects said Decision No. 39681 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
