In the Matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades of the State highway, Route 165, (Arroyo Seco Parkway) and the tracks of the Pacific Electric Railway in the vicinity of Sunset Boulevard and North Figueroa Street, in the City of Los Angeles, State of California.

ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct a crossing of State Highway Route 165 (Arroyo Seco Parkway) at separated grades under the tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company on Sunset Boulevard in the City of Los Angeles, at the location as shown by map, Exhibit "A" attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6H-1.21-B. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing, approved by Pacific Electric Railway Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Prior to construction existing Crossing No. 6H-1.22 shall be closed to public use and travel.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless

time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
