FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

This matter was last considered in June, 1946. At that time applicant's authority to transport property between points in the City and County of San Francisco for Butler Brothers at a rate of 15 cents per 100 pounds, minimum charge 45 cents per shipment, was extended to December 31, 1946. This basis first became effective on January 1, 1946, when it replaced an 11-cent rate, subject to a minimum charge of 30 cents per shipment. Applicant seeks a further 6-month extension of its present authority.

In the verified supplemental application it is alleged that operations under the authorization now outstanding have been compensatory. Applicant states that should increased costs which would make the 15-cent rate noncompensatory materialize during the sought extension an appropriate rate adjustment will be proposed.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought extension should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of Decision

No. 39151 of June 25, 1946, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to June 30, 1947, unless sooner changed, canceled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective January 1, 1947.
