O P I N I O N

Asbury Rapid Transit System pursuant to a certificate granted by Decision No. 31593 is authorized to provide passenger stage service between Pasadena and Arcadia (Santa Anita Race Track of the Los Angeles Turf Club), subject to the restriction that the service be operated only during the racing season and on race days only. A further restriction prohibits the transportation of passengers except those having point of origin or point of destination at the Los Angeles Turf Club.

In the above-entitled application the Commission is requested to authorize applicant to temporarily suspend the foregoing described operation for the 1946 - 1947 racing season, or until applicant is able to acquire sufficient equipment to provide the service. In support of this request applicant asserts that it has on order a number of motor coaches from various sources but has not received a sufficient number of units to enable it at this time to provide this service without seriously impairing its regularly operated service between other points.

After full consideration, we do not believe a public

hearing is required in this matter and that the authority requested should be granted.

ORDER

An application therefor having been made and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Asbury Rapid Transit System may suspend passenger stage operations authorized by Decision No. 31593 between Pasadena and Arcadia (Santa Anita Race Track of the Los Angeles Turf Club) during the 1946 - 1947 racing season.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall within 30 days from the effective date hereof and upon not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public file appropriate supplements to its tariffs and time tables reflecting the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
