ORDER

Sacramento County is authorized to construct a public street at grade across the Walnut Grove branch of Southern Pacific Company near Sacramento in that County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. AU-92.5.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. 75-B.)

Upon completion, two private crossings located about three hundred feet and five hundred feet south of the crossing herein authorized shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective on the date hereof.
