ORDER OF DISMISSAL AND REVOCATION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

By letter dated December 21, 1946, applicant requests dismissal of its 5th Supplemental Application in the above-entitled proceeding and states that it does not intend to resume its passenger stage operations between Los Angeles and Long Beach which have been under suspension since August 1942.

Therefore, and, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the above-entitled 5th Supplemental Application is hereby dismissed and the passenger stage operative right created by Decision No. 28780, dated May 4, 1936, is hereby revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall within 30 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public, cancel all effective tariffs and time tables applicable to the service heretofore provided pursuant to the authority granted by said Decision No. 28780.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
