ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct one main line track at grade across Ramona Boulevard, Baldwin Fark, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6T-17.81, and to remove one branch track, identified as Crossing No. 6T-17.81-C. The former main line track, previously owned by Southern Pacific Company and identified as Crossing No. BZ-501.1, will be reclassified as a spur track and identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6T-17.81. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 2%. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 wigwags, G.O. No. 75-B.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time

be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective upon the date hereof.
