FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 37844, S. F. Spurgeon was authorized to establish and operate a passenger stage service between Quincy Junction and Buck's Lake Lodge and intermediate points.

By supplemental application Spurgeon requests authority to discontinue the foregoing described service which constitutes his entire operation. In support of such request, the verified application states in effect that the revenues received from this operation are wholly inadequate to meet the cost of providing the service.

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by said Decision No. 37844 to S. F. Spurgeon is hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of S. F. Spurgeon are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
