ORDER FOR DISMISSAL

In this proceeding Edgar Raymond Ketchum and Dana E. Ketchum, partners, doing business as Atlas Truck Lines, sought a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the establishment of a highway common carrier service, under Section 50-3/4 of the Public Utilities Act, between the Los Angeles Area, as described in the application, on the one hand, and on the other hand, Calexico, Seeley, Holtville and Niland and certain intermediate and off-route points.

A public hearing was had at Los Angeles on February 26 and March 1, 1945, when the matter was continued for further hearing. Thereafter it was dropped from the calendar. Applicants have now advised that they do not desire to prosecute the application further, and they accordingly request that the proceeding be dismissed.

Pursuant to applicants' request, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the above-entitled proceeding be, and it hereby is dismissed.
