FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 35894 of Application No. 25293 Southern Pacific Company was authorized to construct a crossing of a spur track with Valley Boulevard at Kaiser, San Bernardino County, subject to the condition that the right to maintain this crossing at grade would expire six months after the end of the existing war emergency.

Subsequent to this decision the Department of Public Works of the State of California was authorized in Decision No. 39599 of Application No. 27793 to construct a grade separation for a new highway crossing with said spur track. This highway will carry the principal highway traffic in the vicinity and Valley Boulevard will then become a relatively unimportant road. The Division of Highways has accordingly amended its permit for the Valley Boulevard crossing to provide that the right to this crossing be without time limit.

Southern Pacific Company now requests that the time limit fixed in Decision No. 35894 also be removed. This request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 35894 in Application No. 25293 is hereby amended to eliminate the provision that the

authority therein granted shall expire six months from the end of the existing war emergency. In all other respects said Decision No. 35894 is in full force and effect. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
