FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pursuant to the authority granted by Decision No.  
33696, dated December 3, 1940, McCormick Steamship Company trans-  
ferred its public utility properties to Pope & Talbot, Inc., a  
corporation. The latter was authorized to file, and did file,  
tariffs designated "Pope & Talbot, Inc. (McCormick Steamship  
Company Division)". Applicant's Board of Directors has concluded  
that there is no further need to continue the use of the trade  
name "McCormick Steamship Company Division". It therefore asks  
the Commission to amend Decision No. 33696 so as to grant to  
Pope & Talbot, Inc. any and all rights, benefits and privileges  
previously granted to Pope & Talbot, Inc. (McCormick Steamship  
Company Division).

The Commission has considered applicant's request and  
is of the opinion that this is not a matter on which a hearing is

necessary and that applicant's request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 33696, dated December 3, 1940, is hereby amended so as to make effective to Pope & Talbot, Inc. all rights, benefits and privileges which were by said decision granted to Pope & Talbot, Inc. (McCormick Steamship Company Division).

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted is effective upon the date hereof.
