In the matter of the application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing the construction of a crossing at separated grades of the State highway, Route 5, and the tracks of The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway, southeast of the City of Stockton, San Joaquin County, California.

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route 5 at separated grades under the main line track and a siding of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company near Stockton, San Joequin County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-1119.0-B. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto and copy of said agreement together with plans of said crossing approved by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
