## ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR AMENDMENT OF DECISION

The petition of United Van and Storage Association, Inc., California Van and Storage Association, Alameda County Draymen's Association, and San Francisco Movers, Inc., seeks an amendment to the Commission's Decision No. 39613 issued November 4, 1946. Said decision established rules, regulations and practices to be observed by all classes of highway carriers engaged in the transportation of household goods and related property. Petitioners do not seek an amendment of the rules and regulations thus established. They ask only that the Commission strike from its opinion certain findings which, as they assert, appear to characterize all such carriers as having engaged in improper practices. The Commission has fully considered the petition and it is of the opinion that no good cause appears for an amendment of Decision No. 39613. The

findings contained in the opinion therein were not intended and should not be construed to apply to all carriers engaged in that class of transportation.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the within petition for amendment of Decision No. 39613 issued November 4, 1946, in these proceedings, be and hereby is denied.
