EXFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing the construction of a crossing at grade of Adams Street, near its intersection with Mission Boulevard (State Highway Route 19) and the tracks of the Union Pacific Railroad at the San Bernardino-Riverside County line, California.

ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct Adams Street at grade across the main line tracks of Union Pacific Railroad Company at the San Bernardino-Riverside County line, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 3-43.41. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense. The County of San Bernandino shall bear maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Union Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 22 feet and grades of approach not greater than 5%. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B). Upon completion, Crossing No. 3-43.4, about 50 feet west, shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
