In the Matter of the Application of CALIFORNIA WATER & TELEPHONE COMPANY for the approval of an agreement between Crest Public Utility District and California Water & Telephone Company for the temporary sale and delivery of water.

Application No. 28199

O R D E R

California Water and Telephone Company, a corporation, asks for authority to enter into an agreement with Crest Public Utility District, San Diego County, providing for the sale of water on a temporary basis to aid the district in obtaining a sufficient water supply to meet the demands of its customers.

The agreement provides that the water is being sold as an emergency measure for a period not to exceed two years and that such sale of water is not to be construed as a dedication by the company of its water supply to meet the needs of the district. The quantity of water to be sold is limited to 250 acre feet per year. The district agrees, if it exercises its right under the agreement, to pay a rate of 8 cents per 1,000 gallons for the water delivered and to purchase water in sufficient quantity to total \$1,000 in order to compensate the company for the cost of installing facilities to deliver the water supply.

It appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that California Water and Telephone Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Crest Public Utility District providing for the sale and delivery of water on a temporary basis to said district substantially in accordance with the terms and conditions

set forth in Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein and which is hereby made a part of this Order by reference.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that California Water and Telephone Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of this agreement as finally consummated.

The authority granted herein shall become effective on the date hereof.
