FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission having on February 4, 1947, issued its Decision No. 39943 in the above entitled proceeding, wherein a schedule of rates was established for the domestic and commercial service rendered by the San Gabriel Valley Water Company in and in the vicinity of Fontana, San Bernardino County, and it appearing that a fire hydrant rate was inadvertently omitted from said schedule, now therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Gabriel Valley Water Company, a corporation, may file in quadruplicate, in conformity with General Order No. 96 within ten (10) days from the date of this Order, the following schedule of rates which are hereby found to be just and reasonable rates to be charged for all fire hydrant service rendered in and in the vicinity of Fontana, San Bernardino County, to become effective on the date hereof:

Schedule No. 2

FIRE HYDRANT RATE

Applicability:

Applicable for all water furnished for fire fighting purposes through hydrants owned by Fontana Fire District.

Territory:

In and about the town of Fontana, San Bernardino County.

Rates:

Per Hydrant  
Per Month

For each fire hydrant connected to a main of less than 4-inches in diameter . . . . . \$1.00

For each fire hydrant connected to a main of 4-inches in diameter or larger . . . . . 1.50
