O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route 5 at grade across the Oakdale branch of Southern Pacific Company near Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. DC-93.0. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be substantially as shown on print attached to the application and grades of approach not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 3 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals. (G. O. 75-B) Plan and description of method of operation of said signals shall be filed with the Commission before installation.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety

so require. This order shall be effective upon the date hereof.
