BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for a supplemental order authorizing the construction at grade of railroad industrial spur track across Firebaugh Avenue, in the city of Exeter, County of Tulare, California.

First Supplemental Application No. 27642

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Firebaugh Avenue in Exeter, Tulare County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BC-257.8. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-3).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
