

Decision No. 40093

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, for an order of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California, granting and conferring upon applicant all necessary permission and authority to carry out the terms and conditions of a written agreement with TUOLUMNE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 1, dated February 18, 1947.

Application No. 28266.

ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, asks for authority to carry out the terms and conditions of an agreement with Tuolumne County Water District No. 1, a public corporation, dated February 18, 1947, providing for the sale of water to the District for purification and resale purposes within a resort and summer home colony, known as Twain Harte Tract, located in the vicinity of Confidence, Tuolumne County. The water will be diverted from the Pacific Company's Eureka Ditch and will be sold as an accommodation from such surplus water as may be available in the ditch. The deliveries are not to exceed a flow of fifteen (15) miner's inches⁽¹⁾ of water, and the rate is to be fifty (50) cents per miner's inch day. The agreement is to be effective for the period from January 1, 1947, to and including December 31, 1952.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of a written agreement with Tuolumne County Water District No. 1, a public corporation, dated February 18, 1947, which is attached to the application as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof by reference.

Notes: (1) A miner's inch for the purpose hereof shall mean a continuous flow of water equivalent to 1.5 cubic feet per minute.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within sixty (60) days from the date of this order, two certified copies of the agreement as consummated.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, notify this Commission of the date of termination of said agreement within thirty (30) days thereof.

The effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
