FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Commission by Decision No. 39412, dated September 17, 1946, authorized Midwick Water Company, among other things, to issue and sell, for cash, at \$100 a share, 1,000 shares of its common capital stock for the purpose of paying the cost of constructing and installing a water system to serve a tract of land in Los Angeles County known as the Midwick Country Club and of providing working capital, such sale of stock to be accomplished on or before March 31, 1947, and

WHEREAS, in a supplemental application filed with the Commission on March 26, 1947, Midwick Water Company reports that it has been, and will be, unable to complete its development of its water system or to issue its stock prior to March 31, 1947, but that it expects to be in a position to complete its plans before June 1, 1947,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Midwick Water Company may issue and sell the stock authorized by the order in Decision No. 39412, dated September 17,

1946, be and it hereby is extended to and including May 31, 1947.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 39412, dated September 17, 1946, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
