ORDER

Sonoma County is authorized to construct Industrial Avenue at grade across the main track of Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company near Sebastopol, Sonoma County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 67-15-2. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of line two feet outside of rails. Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four (24) feet and grades of approach not greater than two (2) per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
