ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

It appearing that by Decision No. 30794 of April 18, 1938; in the above-numbered application, H. C. McCULLOUGH, doing business in the name of Monterey-Big Sur Tours, was granted a certificate to operate a sightseeing service as a passenger stage corporation for the continuous round-trip transportation of passengers whose point of origin and destination is either Monterey, Pacific Grove, Carmel, or Carmel Highlands, provided that on the round trip no passenger may be transported through or beyond said passenger's point of origin, said service to be conducted over and along State route No. 1 between Monterey and Big Sur State Park via Pacific Grove, Carmel, and Carmel Highlands, detouring to Carmel Mission, the return movement being over the same route; it appearing further that the 1945 Annual Report of said carrier shows no operating or other revenues whatsoever for that calendar year, and that it is delinquent in the filing of its Annual Report for 1946; it further appearing that no passenger-carrying motor vehicle miles were performed by said carrier during either 1945 or 1946; it further appearing that said carrier has at no time made an application to this Commission for permission to suspend operation and that no such permission has been granted; and it being found that the entire operation and service of said carrier, as authorized by Decision No. 30794 of April 18, 1938,

have been discontinued without authority of the Commission, thereby resulting in abandonment of operation; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the above mentioned operative right of H. C. McCULLOUGH, doing business as Monterey-Big Sur Tours, between the points and over the routes as hereinbefore described, be and the same is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and time tables on file are hereby cancelled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service thereof in the manner provided by law, unless said H. C. McCullough, before such effective date, shall have filed with the Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
