O P I N I O N

In this proceeding Asbury Rapid Transit System, a corporation, seeks authority to suspend, during the 1947 racing season, the operation of motor coach service between Culver City and the race track of Hollywood Turf Club in Inglewood. This operation was established pursuant to Decision No. 30666, rendered February 28, 1938, in Application No. 21606, as an extension of the service between Hollywood and Culver City. Under this decision, the service could be provided only during the racing season at this track, and on race days alone.

During the war period this operation was temporarily suspended, but it was resumed during the 1945-1946 racing season. Because of the difficulties encountered in obtaining delivery of equipment previously ordered, applicant, assertedly, would be unable to restore the service to and from the Hollywood Turf Club during the 1947 racing season, with the equipment now available. To do so, it is stated, would impair the scheduled service now provided under applicant's regular operations. A suspension of this service, therefore, is sought during the current racing season, or until sufficient equipment, now on order, is received to permit the resumption of the

operation.

Under the circumstances the application will be granted.
This is not a matter requiring a public hearing.

O R D E R

Application having been made as above-entitled, the
Commission having considered the matter, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) That Asbury Rapid Transit System be and it is hereby
authorized to suspend, during the 1947 racing season at the Hollywood
Turf Club, in Inglewood, the operation of passenger stage service
between Culver City and the Hollywood Turf Club, in the city of
Inglewood, and intermediate points.

(2) That applicant shall comply with and observe the
following service regulations.

- a. Applicant shall comply with General Order
No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A
by filing, in triplicate, amendments to ~~his~~ *its*
present tariffs and time tables reflecting
the authority herein granted, within 60 days
from the date hereof and upon not less than
one day's notice to the Commission and the
public.
- b. Said service may be resumed only upon notice
to the Commission of not less than one day
prior to the restoration thereof, and upon
compliance with the provisions of General
Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order
No. 93-A.



The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
