ORDER AMENDING DECISION No. 40105

Merchants Express Corporation, by verified petition filed herein, having requested a two-day extension of time within which to file tariffs and time tables as provided by Paragraph (b) of the Fifth Ordering Paragraph of Decision No. 40105 so as to make said tariffs and time tables effective on April 21, 1947 on three days' notice instead of on five days' notice as presently required by said decision, and good cause appearing therefor:

IT IS ORDERED that Paragraph (b) of the Fifth Ordering Paragraph of said Decision No. 40105 be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"b. Within 60 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than 3 days' notice to the Commission and the public, Merchants Express Corporation shall establish the service herein authorized and applicants shall comply with the provisions of General Order No. 80 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-2 by filing in triplicate and concurrently making effective appropriate tariffs and time tables relating to the service established pursuant to the transfer of the operative right, and to the issuance of the certificate, herein authorized."

In all other respects said Decision No. 40105 shall be and remain in full force and effect.

It further appearing from said petition that this is a matter of urgency, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
