ORDER

The City of San Fernando is authorized to construct
Truman Street at grade across Southern Pacific Company's spur track
connection to Pacific Electric Railway Company in the City of San
Fernando at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-462.09-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense; also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet
outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance
cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than
fifty feet and grades of approach not greater than 1%. Construction
shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs, G.O. No. 75-B.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,

necessity or safety so require. This order shall become effective twenty days from the flate hereof.
