## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By its First Supplemental Application, Fialer's Limousines, Inc. requests a 90-day extension of time within which to commence the air-line passenger service between Mills Field, San Josc and intermediate points authorized by Decision No. 40009, issued February 25, 1947, in this proceeding. As justification for the request it is stated that commitments by manufacturers for delivery of motor vehicles by April 15, 1947, have not been kept, and that from the best information now available additional vehicles suitable for the proposed service will be delivered by July 15, 1947. Applicant states it is believed preferable to maintain efficiently its existing services, alleged to be increasing in traffic volume, rather than to divert needed equipment to the new service. In any event, it is alleged, the additional service will be inaugurated within the 90-day extended period, on 5 day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Applicant's request appears to be reasonable, and it will accordingly be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that paragraph (b) of the second ordering paragraph of Decision No.40009 herein be and it is hereby amended to

read as follows:

"b. Within 150 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A, by filing in triplicate and concurrently making effective, appropriate tariffs and time tables."

In all other respects said Decision No. 40009 shall be and remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
