ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct the following tracks at grade across streets within the City of Culver City at the locations described in the application, to be identified as follows:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Number of Tracks</u>	<u>Assigned Crossing No.</u>
Hays Street	One spur	6A-10.56-C
Hayden Avenue	Two spurs	6A-10.78-C
Eastham Drive	One spur	6A-10.99-C

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without super-elevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs G.O. No. 75-B.

Prior to the construction applicant shall furnish the Commission with a certified copy of an ordinance issued by the City of Culver City for a franchise to operate across said streets. Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

This order shall be effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
